ASQ's From A to Z



The <u>Ages and Stages Questionnaire</u> is a developmental screening tool used to identify children at risk for developmental delays. ASQ's can provide early identification of potential developmental delays or the need for further assessment, but what happens next? This tool provides teachers and parents/caregivers with valuable information to help guide them through the process. All School Readiness children ages 0-5 are required to receive this screening upon enrollment into the program, either by their parent/guardian or the contracted child care provider. Learn more about the Rule and Legislation that govern this requirement, as well as how to complete the questionnaire correctly, why accuracy is so important, and how to interpret the results. It is <u>essential</u> that anyone completing and utilizing this tool understand how to do so properly.
