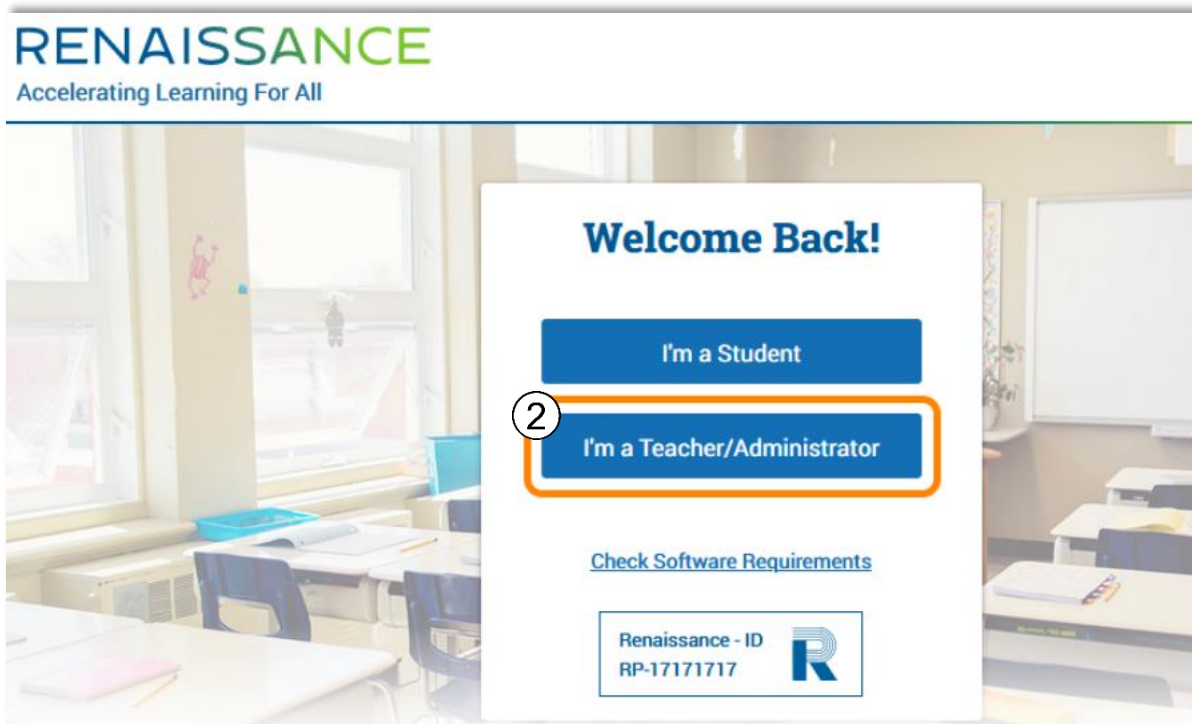
## Logging In (Administrators)

1. In your web browser, go to the URL (web address) for your [Renaissance](#) site.
2. On the Renaissance start page, select **I'm a Teacher/Administrator**.

**Note:** It is asking for a Renaissance ID. What is that?

The username is (sch) + (your VPK Provider Portal ID) Example: sch1234

The password is vpk (lowercase). You will be asked to change this once logged in the first time.



## Logging In (Teachers)

1. In your web browser, go to the URL (web address) for your [Renaissance](#) site.
2. On the Renaissance start page, select **I'm a Teacher/Administrator**.

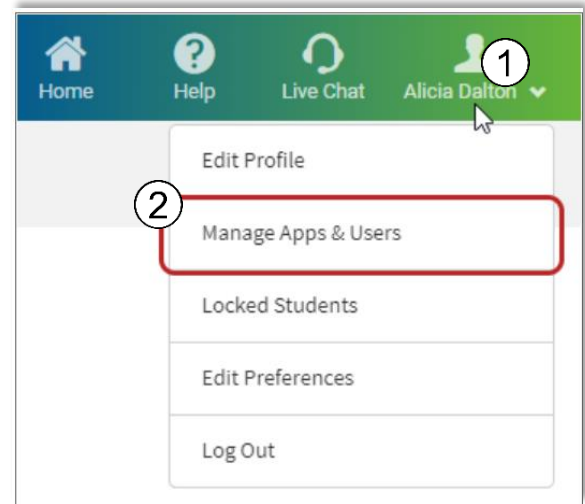
**Note:** It is asking for a Renaissance ID. What is that?

Teachers must obtain a Renaissance ID from an Administrator. Administrators can view the teacher login information once they have logged in to the VPK Renaissance testing site.

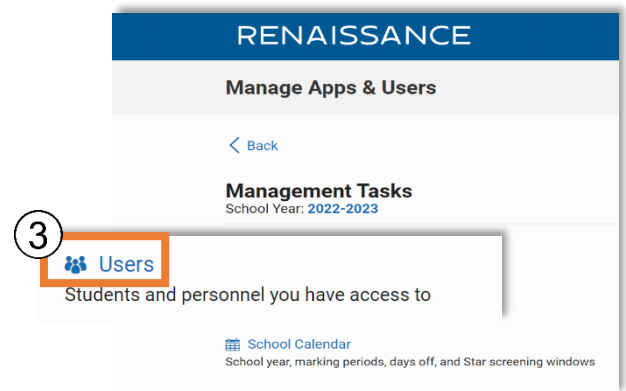
**Administrators**, follow the steps below:

3. Select **Users**.

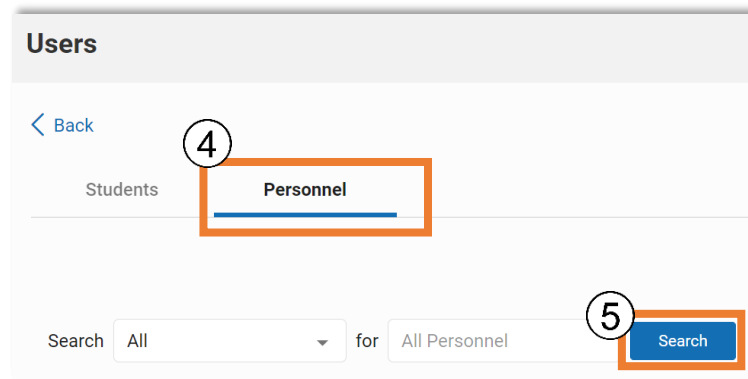


4. Select **Personnel**.

Note: The teacher username starts with a lowercase t. Example t123456

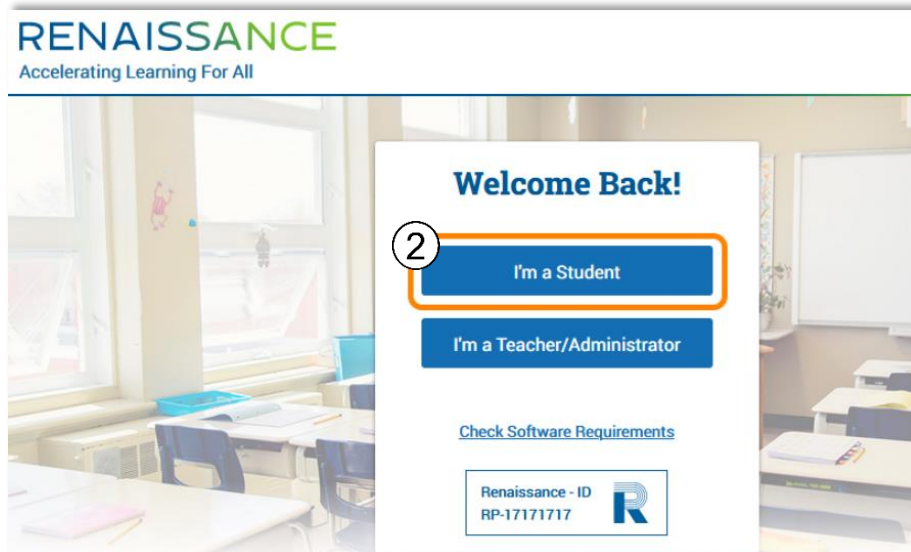
The teacher password is vpk (lowercase).

Teachers will be asked to change this once logged in the first time.



## Logging In (Students)

1. In your web browser, go to the URL (web address) for your [Renaissance](#) site.
2. On the Renaissance start page, select **I'm a Student**.



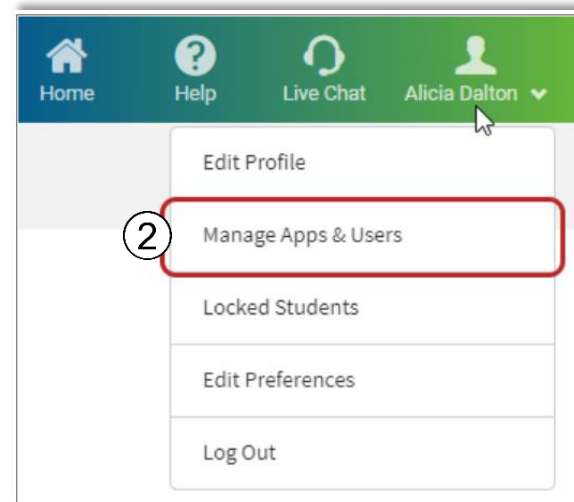
**Note:** It is asking for a Renaissance ID. What is that?

Students must obtain a Renaissance ID from an Administrator. Administrators can view the student login information once they have logged in to the VPK Renaissance testing site.

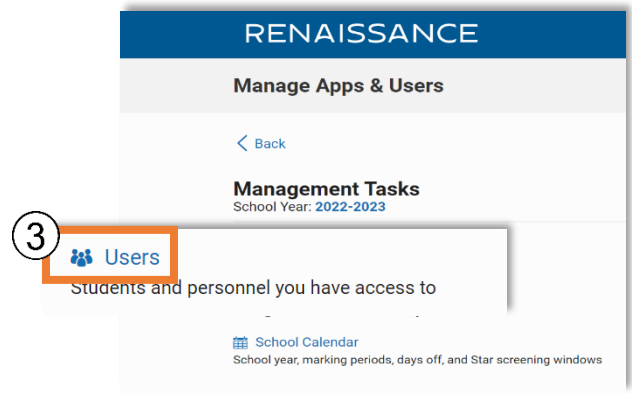
**Administrators**, follow the steps below:

3. Select **Users**.

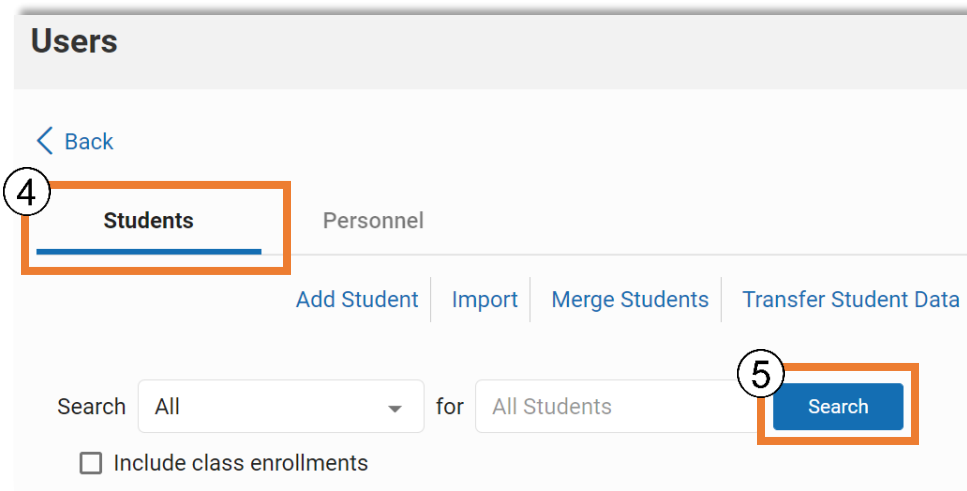


4. Select **Students**.

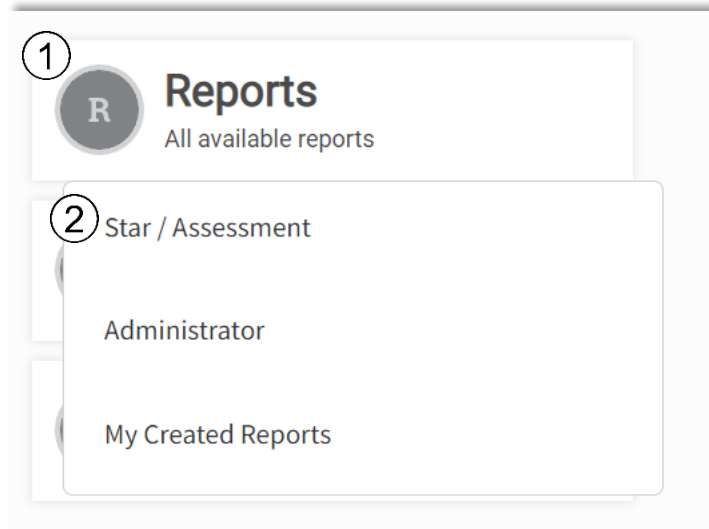

# Reports – Exploring your student’s results

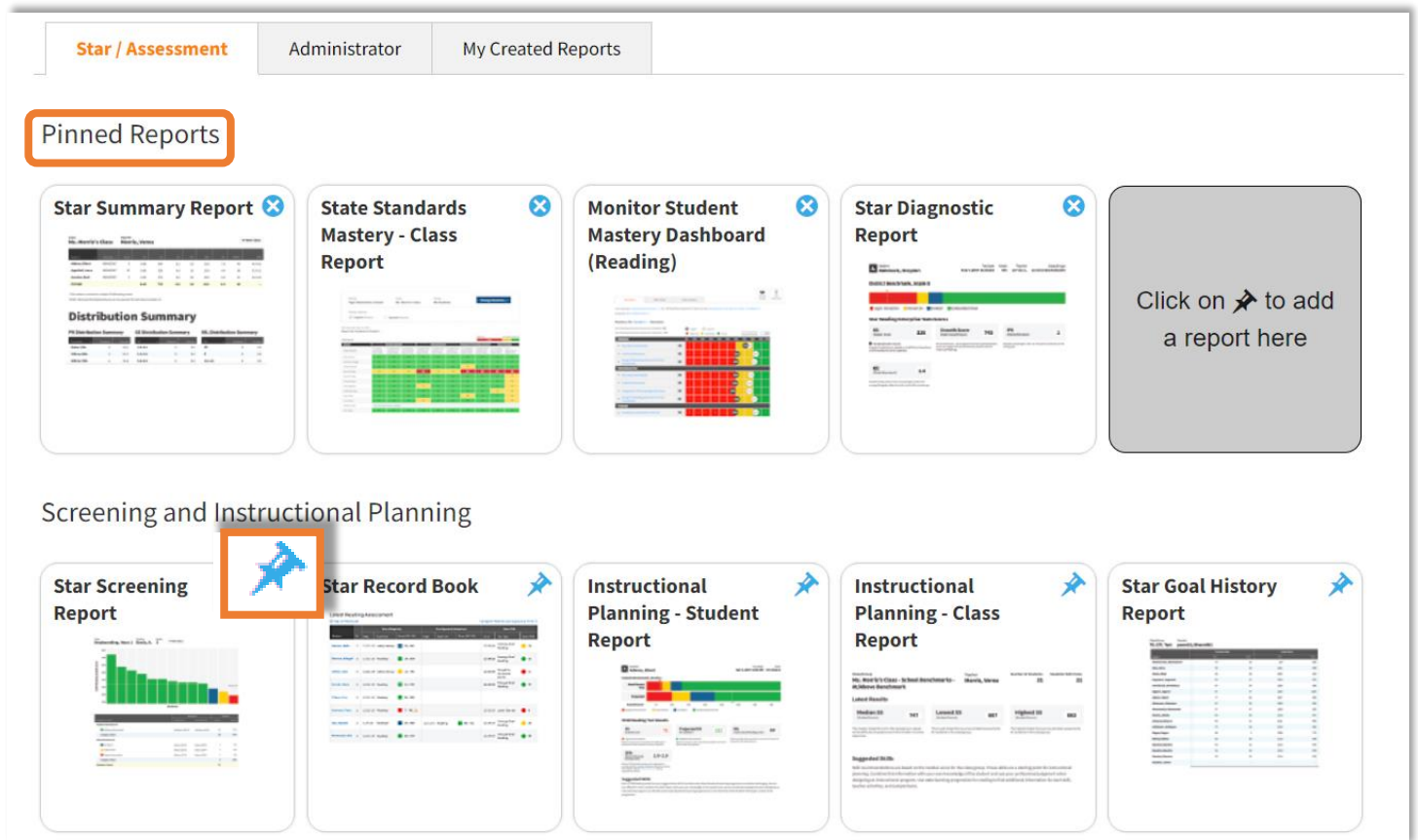
Administrators and Teachers can view reports once you login to the VPK Renaissance testing site.

From the Home page,

You can “Pin” reports to the top of the page for easy access by clicking on the pin icon in the top right corner of the report.





## Star Parent Report

Provides printable informational letter for parents or guardians, available in English and Spanish.  
**Required to be given out within 7 days of completion of assessment.**

**Note:** This report is located in the *Parent and Other Reports* section of the **Reports** page.

## Customize Report

1. Click **Change Students** to All Classes or Select Classes.
2. Click **Update Report**.
3. Click PDF icon at the top to save or print reports. This may take a minute to process.  
 **Suggestion:** Print 2 copies (for your records and for parent records)

SS: The [Scaled Score](#) Scaled Score (SS) is the most fundamental score produced by assignments and tests. It ranges from 0–1400 and spans grades 1–12.

PR: [Percentile Rank](#) scores range from 1 to 99 and express student ability relative to the scores of other students in the same grade.
