Children who grow up without access to both responsible & accountable parents are:

- 4X more likely to Live in Poverty
- 9X more likely to Drop out of School
- 11X more likely to have Violent Behavior
- 20X more likely to be Incarcerated
- 10X more likely to Abuse Chemical Substances

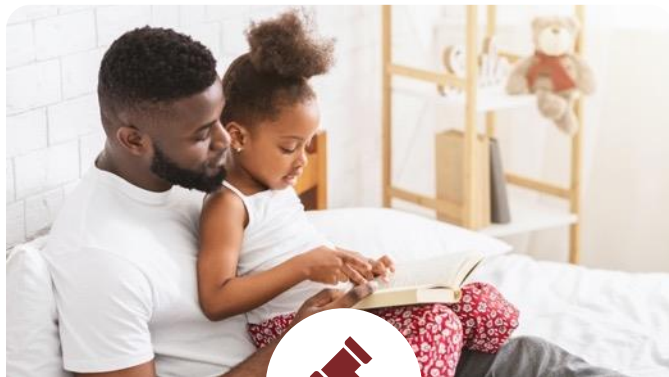

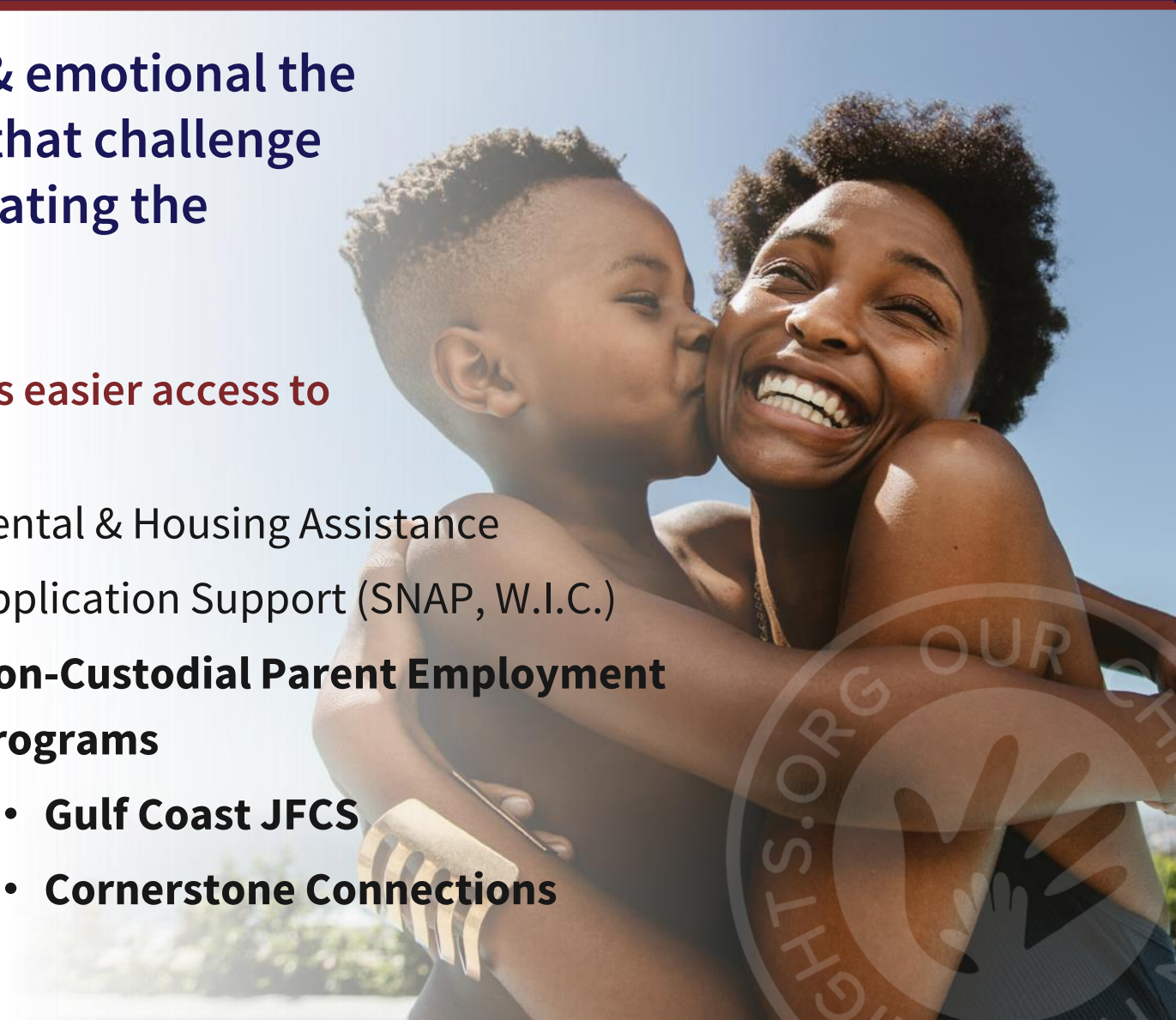

CORNERSTONE CONNECTIONS H.O.P.E. program.

HOPE is an acronym for *Healing, Opportunity, Perseverance*, and *Empowerment*. **HOPE** connects all of these in a supportive manner, through a host of specialized services designed to help non-custodial parents obtain employment.

This program engages and works with non-custodial parents who are *unemployed or underemployed and have been court ordered to pay child support*.

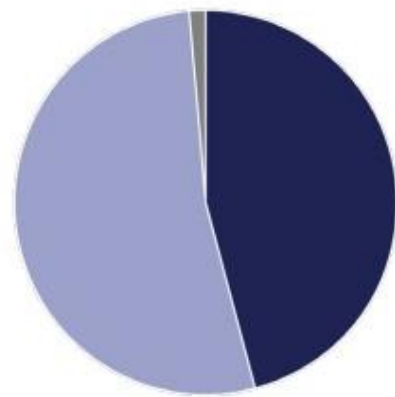

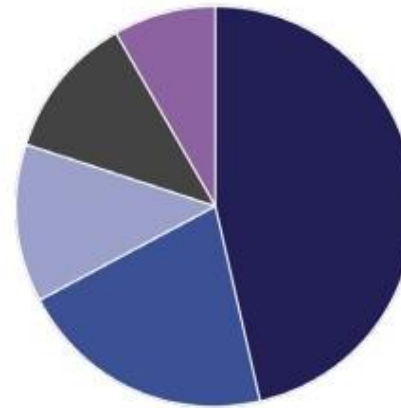

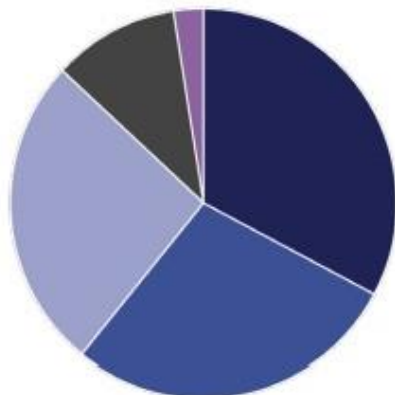

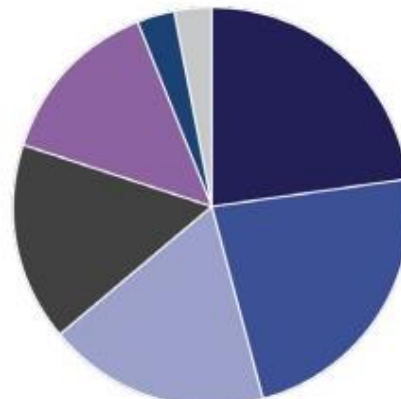

MARITAL STATUS

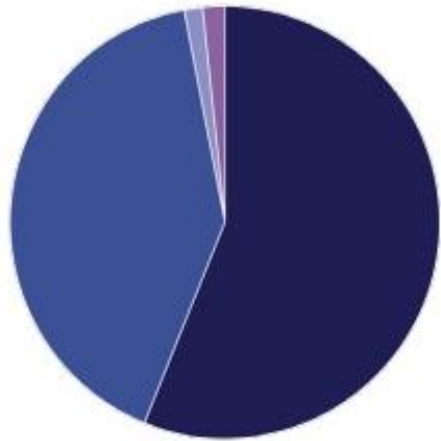

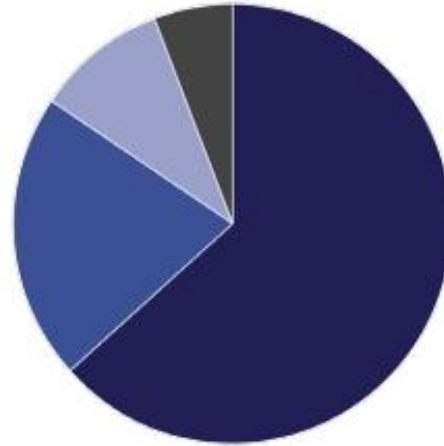

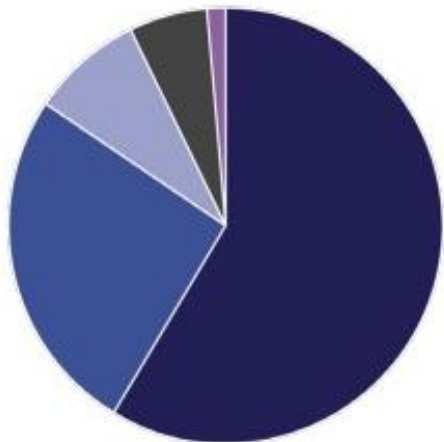

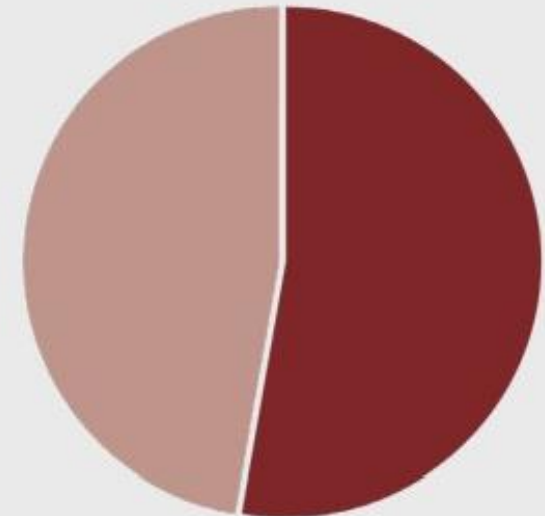

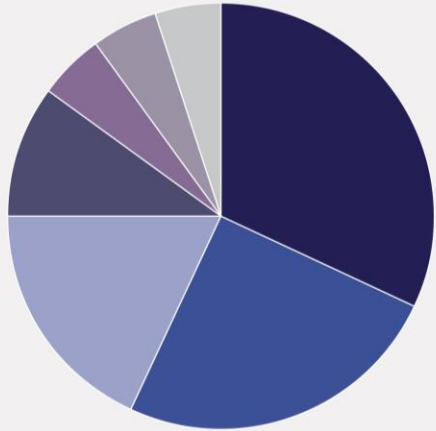

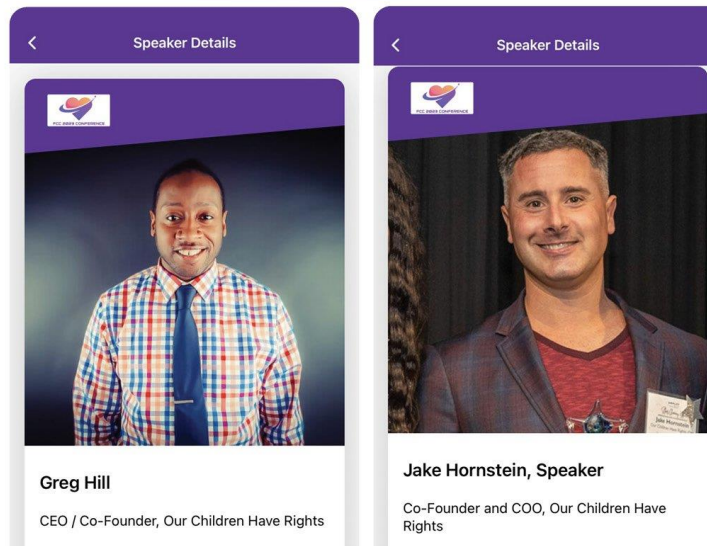


Florida Coalition For Children Annual Conference, Bonita Springs Florida

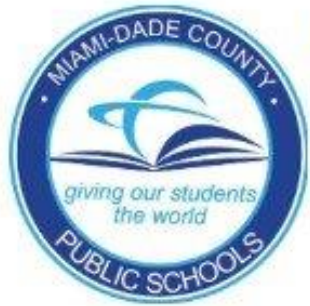

I attempted to communicate with her again today, regarding the parenting plan between her, and I, and I got no response as usual.

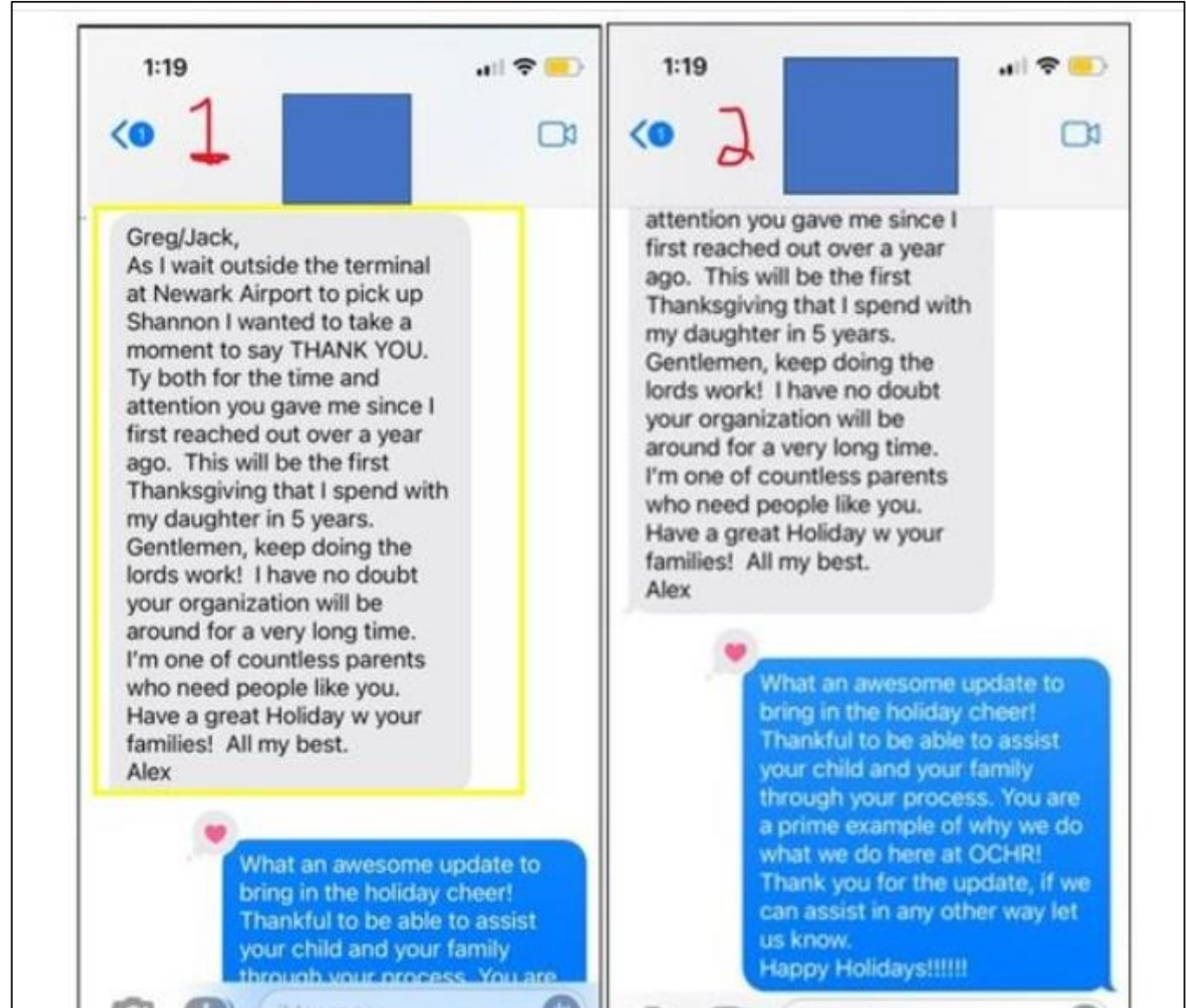
I will submit these documents to you tomorrow afternoon.
