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

In addition, she is a keynote speaker, an Iron Man triathlete, races motor cycles, and is a certified scuba diver, among other hobbies. Ms. Skoczelas is passionate about attracting and keeping girls in STEM, and encouraging young people to become STEM teachers. She has garnered four industry awards for her work as the title character in The Professor Sko Science Show.

Despite being a self-avowed introvert, Brenda appears in YouTube videos, stage performances, and public appearances in order to, in her words... "be the role model I wish I had so no girl ever has to do without one again."Brenda earned her bachelor's degree in Mathematics and master's degree in Physics from Ball State University. Her research background includes the development of non-invasive diagnostic procedures using the magnetic field for testing to assess potential nerve damage.
